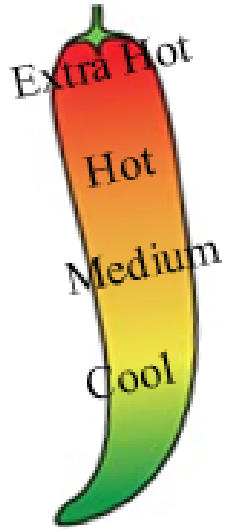

Produce a list of questions to ask them about their life and their music. Create a mock interview, answering your questions. You can choose to present this in any format. (magazine article, radio interview etc...)</p> 
<p>Listening 4HP Listen to 3 pieces of music from this month's style and describe what you hear in short sentences. Listen out for the use of: Dynamics, Tempo, Pitch, Instruments. Add a sentence for each to explain how the music makes you feel.</p> 	<p>PowerPoint Slideshow 4HP Using PowerPoint create an informative slideshow which explains all about this month's music style. Include musical clips and links to YOUTUBE performances.</p>
